LDC PROGRESSING THE LCC FOR THE TERRITORY'S FUTURE

The LDC has taken another significant step in the progress of its Larrakia Cultural Centre Development, with the engagement of a Project Manager to oversee the LCC's build over the coming years.

With over 30 applications the LDC sought to employ a Project Manager with experience in the design and project management of multi-disciplinary iconic buildings in the NT and Australia. After a strong vetting process, the LDC is pleased to announce that as of the 14 December 2020, Angelique Brett will be joining the LDC team as the full time Project Manager to lead the ongoing design and construction process.

Angelique is a certified Architect and Project Manager who has worked on several infrastructure projects during her career in the NT and interstate. Angelique was involved in the development of previous phases of the LCC and brings a strong understanding and passion for the project to her new role.

The LCC continues to be a key project for the LDC since 2005, and will result in a facility for Larrakia language, art, and cultural teaching, while providing locals and other visitors an opportunity to explore Larrakia culture and history. The LCC Business Case completed in 2018 indicated that the facility will provide ongoing economic benefit to the NT beyond the design and construction phases.

Following LDC's announcement of the Architectural Firms shortlisted for the LCC's Detailed Design, those firms and their locally based architectural, engineering, landscaping, survey, and geotechnical teams are currently preparing respective tender submissions for the LCC. The tendering phase is another step towards the development of this significant facility for the NT, Darwin and Larrakia.
