## Call out to all Larrakia Artists!

The LDC continues to progress the Larrakia Cultural Centre's design phase with a call out to all Larrakia artists for a chance to showcase their talent in the design of the nationally significant development.

Larrakia language, history and culture will be celebrated and shared with the world through the Larrakia Cultural Centre (LCC). This includes the promotion of Larrakia artwork and Larrakia artists within the design elements of the LCC and through its exhibition spaces.

The LDC is therefore calling out for all established and emerging Larrakia artists to participate in its Registration of Interest. The selected Larrakia artists will be directly engaged by LDC to work alongside the architectural and engineering design team, Rossi Architects and Susan Dugdale and Associates, to develop a range of designs and art, for integration into the building.

Integrated art may take the form of:

- Perforated shade screens or acoustic panels;
- patterning for glazing film;
- embossing or inlay to flooring, ceiling or wall material;
- sculpture; or
- murals.

The LDC remains focussed on opening the LCC at the foot of Chinute Chinute (Stoke's Hill sacred site) by 2023, to be a focus point for Larrakia, Darwinites and visitors seeking a definitive cultural experience.
